Sequence for addressing the remaining West TSA subareas

Staff has developed a set of new subarea boundaries and the progression for the CCG's subarea work. There are four subareas and the work will proceed north to south. The subareas (see map link) and the order they will be discussed are:

1. **Sanitas / Anemone / Red Rocks Subarea.** Boundary: Linden Avenue south to Boulder Canyon.
2. **Flagstaff / Western Mountain Parks HCA Subarea.** Boundary: Boulder Canyon to the south boundary of the Western Mountain Parks Habitat Conservation Area (HCA). Includes Elephant Butte, the Flagstaff Road / Summit area, and the entire HCA.
3. **Chautauqua / Flatirons Subarea.** Boundary: Baseline to Bear Canyon. Includes Gregory Canyon, Chautauqua, Enchanted Mesa, NCAR, and the Flatirons.
4. **Shanahan / South Mesa Subarea.** Boundary: Bear Canyon to Eldorado Springs Drive. Includes Shanahan Ridge / Big Bluestem area and the South Mesa area.

Report from the June 9th, 2010 OSBT meeting

Shelley Dunbar has agreed to replace Art in the Central area and Guy Burgess with take over for Scott in the South neighborhood area. The board also expressed their appreciation for all of the CCG members and their support for this process.

Enhanced Public Outreach Ideas

Several speakers from the community also stated until now they had not heard about the West TSA process. To address this concern the board asks that we discuss how to increase our public outreach efforts to the community at the June 18th OSBT retreat ([Agenda](#)). The retreat will be held in the Weiser room at the OSMP Cherryvale office and is open to the public but not open for public comment. Some of these ideas include stories in the paper, radio programs, notices at trailheads, posters in stores and better use of electronic communication.

Update about the visitor survey results from the Spring Brook Loop Trail

Staff has updated the OSBT about visitor survey results from the Spring Brook Loop Trail. Staff proposed outreach and education responses to mitigate some recreational conflict occurring. Staff is gathering additional ideas from the community to include in an analysis of other management actions that will be presented to the OSBT on July 14, 2010.
